2. Represents stock options awarded on July 31, 2019, pursuant to the Plan. Unvested stock options vest in installments as follows: (a) 8,286 options on July 31, 2022, and 8,287 options on each of the first two anniversaries thereof; and (b) 9,207 options on each of the first two anniversaries of the closing of the IPO, and 9,208 options on the 273rd day following the second anniversary of the closing of the IPO, subject to earlier forfeiture or acceleration.
